Additional Considerations for Dog Parks



- 1. Have two areas: one for smaller dogs and one for larger dogs. List area distinctions on the Park Rules.
- 2. Be sure to post a sign indicating which area is for smaller dogs and which area is for smaller dogs.
- 3. Make the small dog area for dogs that are 30 pounds or less.
- 4. Require park registration so that all dogs and owners in the parks are known.
- 5. Do not allow dogs and owners outside of the community to use the dog park.
- 6. Prohibit spike, pinch, and prong collars while inside the park.
- 7. Install a shaded area and seating for dogs and humans to rest and cool off.
- 8. Install a human and dog accessible water fountain.
- 9. Install a bag dispenser and waste receptacle.
