Dog Park Rules Should Be Clearly Posted



Dog Park Rules Should Include the Following:

- 1. Owners are legally and financially responsible for all of their dog's actions and behaviors, including any injuries caused by their dog.
- 2. All dogs must remain on a leash while outside the park.
- 3. When inside the park, owner must be present, attentive, and carry leash at all times.
- 4. Dogs must wear a collar displaying licenses and be up to date on all their vaccinations.
- 5. No ill, injured, or aggressive dogs are allowed. If any dog becomes ill, injured, or aggressive they must be removed immediately.
- 6. Owners must clean up after their dogs.
- 7. Owners must discourage dogs from digging holes or excessive barking. If holes are dug, the owner must refill them.
- 8. Children under eight years old are now allowed in the park. All children in the park must be closely supervised by an adult at all times.
- 9. Puppies under four months are not allowed in the dog park.
- 10. No more than two dogs per adult.
- 11. No human food or dog food is allowed.
- 12. No smoking or alcohol use is allowed.
- 13. No glass containers are allowed.
- 14. Owners who fail to comply with any and all rules and regulations will be barred from the park.

- 1. Hours of the dog park.
- 2. Phone number for the nearest Animal Control Officer.
